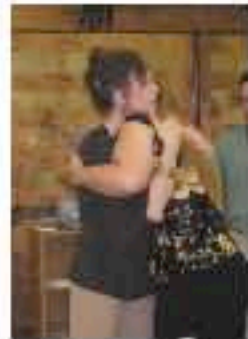


## Facts About Addiction

- One in four deaths in the U.S. can be attributed to alcohol, tobacco, or illicit drug use.
- 9 million children live with a parent dependent on alcohol and/or illicit drugs.
- 9.3% of adults age 18-49 who are employed full time, admitted dependence on alcohol and/or illicit drugs.
- Untreated addiction is more expensive than heart disease, diabetes and cancer combined.
- More than 75% of domestic violence victims report that their assailant had been drinking or using illicit drugs at the time of the incident.
- Surveys show that teenagers are more likely to abuse prescription medicine than illicit drugs or alcohol.
- More than half of all adults have a family history of alcoholism or problem drinking.

## Program Overview

**Residential Treatment** This three month program offers one of the finest success rates for alcohol and drug treatment anywhere in the United States. Many addicts choose outpatient treatment services. However, statistics prove that longer term residential treatment is more effective.

**Spiritual Emphasis** Each day begins with morning devotion and ends with an evening chapel service. A spiritual approach to recovery helps clients recognize that the answers to life's questions can be found in the Word of God.

**Education** Classroom education is essential and offers an atmosphere where learning is at its best. Topics include: Fundamentals of Christianity, Addictive Lifestyles & Behaviors, Relationship Building, Relapse Prevention, Parenting, Basic Life Skills, and an Adult Education Program.



**Counseling** Clients participate in individual and group counseling sessions. They are encouraged to recognize emotions, communicate more effectively, and identify core issues essential to lasting recovery.

**Activity Program** Exercise, recreation and program activities are key elements in building work ethic, team building and development of healthy life skills.

## Residential Facilities



### The Home of Grace for Men

is located in Vancleave, approximately 24 miles northeast of Biloxi, Mississippi. This 100 acre site on beautiful Bluff Creek is a rural setting that promotes a peaceful environment for treatment. Men live in separate four bed cottages, accomodating up to 100 men.



### The Home of Grace for Women

is located in Gautier, approximately 26 miles east of Biloxi, Mississippi. This campus provides a private setting that promotes a safe and healing environment for women. Women live in four bed dormitory rooms and separate 4 bed cottages, accomodating up to 40 women.
